Re: Brianna Herrmann, age 15, disappeared on April 29, 2015 from her home in San Diego, California. Brianna was reported missing to the San Diego Police Department and the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children

A known drug dealer, 19-year-old Timothy Dean Rivera, took Brianna. Rivera took Brianna to an East Los Angeles home in El Sereno, CA. SIA sent 3 teams of operators to the home. The Saved In America team coordinated with the Los Angeles Police Department Hollenbeck Division. The LAPD officers gathered information and confirmed Brianna had, in fact, been in the residence. After gaining entry to the home, with permission of the owners, the SIA team determined Brianna had left a few days earlier. The teams traced her to Venice, CA. Further Investigation lead the teams to Inglewood, CA and Hollywood, CA. Eventually, SIA followed the trail to Reno, Nevada then Texas.

Tips from the SIA hotline lead the team to Jacksonville, Florida. Brianna was rescued in Jacksonville, Florida due to the hard and relentless work of her parents and investigators, the Los Angeles Police Department, the Jacksonville County Sheriff's Office, The Florida Association of Licensed Investigators, and the tipster who directly led the team to specific locations of both Timothy Dean Rivera and Brianna Herrmann within Jacksonville, Florida.

Brianna is now safely in an undisclosed location, and recovering from a horrific ordeal. The public's concern is greatly appreciated, as well as their efforts to assist throughout in finding Brianna. With respect to the reward, the two young women who came forward out of pure kindness and concern will share the \$10,000 reward.
